

For your safety, please remain in the lagoon during rough weather or when swimming or snorkelling unaccompanied. Kindly be advised that there are no full time life guards patrolling the beach or swimming pools. Life jackets have been provided in your villa for emergencies. Buoyancy jackets are available at Blue Journeys Dive and Activity Centre for your convenience. Infant life vests are also encouraged and are available upon request. Swimming is at your own risk.

Pool opening times are 7:00 am - 7:00 pm (please be aware that pool maintenance and treatment takes place post 7:00 pm).

In line with our endeavour to be eco-friendly, Hadahaa bottled still and sparkling water is produced on the island using the classic crystal purification system. The bottle is reusable, saving Park Hyatt Maldives Hadahaa from disposing about 100,000 of plastic bottles each year.

We will provide our Hadahaa Water complimentary in your villa, main pool and main beach. Our Housekeeping Team will replenish the bottles twice daily.

HOUSEKEEPING

Our villa attendants provide services twice a day to clean and tidy your room. This service normally occurs between 9:00 am – 2:00 pm and 6:30 pm – 9:00 pm.

If you prefer for us to service your room at other time periods during the day, we would be delighted to accommodate your request. In line with our environmental commitment, we encourage you to participate in our energy conservation program where all your linen and towels will be replaced every second night of your stay rather than daily.

Should you wish to change your linen and towels daily, please place the Conserve card on your bed and put your towels on the floor.

LAUNDRY SERVICES

We offer same-day laundry services for garments handed in before noon. Due to the harsh impact of dry cleaning chemicals on the environmental and our philosophy in this regard, we do not provide a dry cleaning facility at the resort. Laundry bags are located in the wardrobe for your convenience.

Please inform our Guest Services team when you would like them collected. Alternatively should you prefer, your villa attendant will be happy to complete and submit the laundry on a daily basis on your behalf if requested.

Laundry is charged at the rates listed on the card in your room. An express service is also available upon request between the hours of 8:00 am and 6:00 pm.

Items will be returned within three hours. This service is subject to a 50% surcharge. One-hour pressing services are offered throughout the day for your convenience.

LOCAL CUSTOMS

Please feel comfortable to dress as you wish on the island while respecting the fact that any form of nudity is banned in the Maldives and carries a fine. This includes topless sunbathing.

We recommend our female guests visiting local islands to cover their shoulders and thighs and not wear see-through clothing, out of respect for local culture and customs. We request that in the bar and the restaurants, our female guests also wear a cover up over bathing suits and that men cover bare chests.

LOUNGE & LIBRARY

Our Guest Services Lounge and Library offer satellite television, internet access and a selection of magazines. We also offer classic books and a specialised research section on the history and evolution of the Maldives. For your entertainment you will also find a selection of movies and music discs.

MALÉ Malé is the capital of the Maldives with a population of

approximately 110,000 people. Malé, which is only 1.77 square miles in size, is said to be the most densely populated

city in the world.

MOSQUE A mosque is available for Muslims to use on the island. If you

would like to attend daily prayers, please advise Guest Services by dialing '0' on your villa phone who will arrange for a person

to guide you to the mosque for prayer.

NON-SMOKING Please be advised that out of respect for other guests, it is our

policy to provide a smoke-free environment within our restaurant dining areas, therefore smoking is not permitted in The Dining Room or The Island Grill. All our villas are non-smoking and should you wish to smoke you will find an ashtray placed upon







RESORT SAFETY

As we are concerned with your well being while staying with us, we ask that you familiarize yourself with the following tips.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the unlikely event of an emergency, please dial '0' immediately to notify the Guest Services team. Our Emergency Response Team will then be alerted.

Further details outlining our safety measures and procedures can be found on the back of your villa door, where you will see an Emergency Evacuation map. We would appreciate if you could please make the time to review this information once you have settled in.

FOGGING

In order to control insects on the island, we schedule fogging early morning and evening on a daily basis. This service incorporates a 'fogging machine' which generates insecticide vapours or mist to eliminate mosquito breeding.

The insecticides used are permitted for public hygiene, produced in the United States of America and meet the requirements of the USA and European hygiene standards and are approved by the World Health Organisation.

KEYS

For your security we recommend you leave your villa keys with our Guest Services team whenever you leave the resort for diving, excursions, activities or other off-site experiences. Should you require an additional key, please contact our Guest Services team.

LOST & FOUND

The Housekeeping team will be pleased to assist you in tracing your lost property. Please contact our Guest Services by dialing '0' on your villa phone for assistance.

SAFETY

Warning signs around the hotel are intended for your safety; we ask that you read and obey them.

SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX

Your villa is provided with a personal safe. Instructions for use can be found in the safe. We request that your cash or valuables are kept secured in the safe throughout your stay as cash and credit cards are not required within the resort as we operate a cashless system in our restaurants. The resort will not be held responsible for any lost, damaged or stolen property.

Our Guest Services team will provide a gentle reminder to collect all your belongings prior to departure.

SEA STRINGERS

Although not present in large numbers, we do occasionally get sea stingers and jellyfish in the waters around Hadahaa.

- A crown jellyfish –this is large and firm with an unusual spiked crown-like structure on the top of the bell. They are beautiful to see underwater, a light purple colour with orange mouth organs. They have short tentacles and their large size means that they are easy to see and avoid when in the water. They can sting, but are not considered to be seriously dangerous.
- Juvenile Portuguese Man-of-War, Similar to jelly-fish, these animals can inflict a painful sting. The body is made of a transparent bubble that floats on the surface with one long dark blue tentacle that can be about 1 meter in length and very fine, making them hard to see. This species is not able to swim, it simply floats on the surface and may become washed up on the beach. Even once broken or out of the water, the tentacles can continue to sting. Symptoms should be treated immediately, hot water (+ 40°C) to inactivate the venom and a steroid cream can be obtained from the doctor.
- A by-the-wind-Sailor, which looks similar to the Portuguese man-of-war, its body consists of a blue disc and a firm triangular "sail". This species does not have tentacles and cannot sting.

We encourage you to exercise caution while swimming and we would be more than happy to provide a wetsuit so you can continue to enjoy the snorkelling on our house reef.

If you would like any further information about the jellyfish or would like to arrange a reef exploration trip to snorkel in a different area of the atoll please contact our Marine Biologist and the team at Blue Journeys Dive & Activity Centre.

SNORKELLING

It is not advisable to snorkel during low tide as you may injure yourself on the corals as well as damage them. By standing on the ocean bottom whilst snorkelling you will also damage the corals so please take extreme care.
